





























# COVID-19 PREVENTION PLAN

## EMPLOYEE RESPONSIBILITIES

While your managers and supervisors do play a role in making sure that the COVID-19 Prevention Plan is effective, you and your coworkers also have a role in implementing the plan. You can keep in compliance with your company's COVID-19 Prevention Plan by doing the following:

- Inform your supervisor if you are feeling sick and follow all return-to-work policies and procedures after you have recovered. Do NOT go to work if you are sick.
- Additionally, you should inform your supervisor about any close contact that you have had with people who have been diagnosed with COVID-19.
- Attend all COVID-19 and pandemic-related training and safety meetings. To make sure that you're accounted for, remember to sign off on attendance sheets and lesson signoffs.
- Follow all company policies and procedures for social distancing during outbreaks.
- Follow all company policies and procedures for face coverings.
- Practice proper sneezing and coughing etiquette by using a tissue or your elbow. Remember to wash your hands after throwing tissues away.
- Avoid touching your face with unwashed hands.
- Practice proper hand hygiene by washing your hands with soap and water for a minimum of 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use a hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol. Do NOT use hand sanitizers that contain methyl alcohol.
- If applicable, wear provided personal protective equipment. Equipment may include gloves, goggles, or face shields.
- Become familiar with your company's policies and procedures for the voluntary use of N95s. Please note that N95s can be requested for voluntary use by any employee.
- Cooperate with all company COVID-19 investigations.
- And monitor yourself for symptoms before going to work.

## CENTER FOR DISEASE CONTROL (CDC) AND COVID-19 VACCINATIONS

Vaccines have been made publicly available under an Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) from the Food and Drug Administration. Currently, the CDC states, "All COVID-19 vaccines currently available in the United States are effective at preventing COVID-19 as seen in clinical trial settings. COVID-19 vaccination helps protect people from getting sick or severely ill with COVID-19 and might also help protect people around them. Some people who are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 will still get sick because no vaccine is 100% effective. Experts continue to monitor and evaluate how often this occurs, how severe their illness is, and how likely a vaccinated person is to spread COVID-19 to others."
