Capitol Connection Q&A for Contractors Week of 2/19/2024 By Shauna Krause, President, Capitol Services, Inc.

2024 sprouted a new limb on tree service licensing in CA, and the new class will be tested! The old class is dismissed. I also help a HVAC contractor plumb some new opportunity and 'reconstruct' the rules on remediation work...

Just a reminder that the new "C-49" (Tree and Palm) classification took effect on January 1, 2024 and the CSLB is now accepting applications for the new "C-49". The CSLB created this classification to ensure tree service contractors are tested on health and safety protocols in the tree service industry.

CSLB will no longer accept applications for the "C-61"/"D-49" (Tree Service) limited specialty classification. Applications received for the "C-61"/"D-49", Tree Service classification, will be processed as a "C-49" or Tree and Palm application. Contractors who wish to specialize in tree service work who do not hold a "C-61"/"D-49" (Tree Service) classification will need to apply for the new "C-49" (Tree and Palm) Contractor classification.

Bad news is, all applicants for the "C-49" Tree and Palm Contractor classification will need to sit for a trade examination regardless of other license classifications they hold. The good news is the CSLB will prioritize the application experience review for "C-49" applicants that have held an active "C-61" / "D-49" (Tree Service) license for at least four years.

Contractors who hold a "C-61" / "D-49" (Tree Service) classification issued before January 1, 2024, may retain and work under that classification. However, "C-61" / "D-49" are encouraged to apply for the new Tree and Palm classification, which will become the industry standard. While the "C-49" and older "C-61" / "D-49" classification descriptions differ slightly (the "C-49" description includes palms) CSLB regards the classification of work as the same.

Q: I am a "C-20" contractor and am looking to add the "C-36" (Plumbing) classification. As part of my HVAC work, I frequently install boilers, do pipe insulation, etc. I understand I will be required to take the "C-36" trade exam, but do I need to re-take the law portion of the exam?

A: No, you will not be required to re-take the law exam.

Q: Does a company need a license from the Board to do water remediation work for a personal property owner? We remove tile flooring, subfloor, baseboards, carpets and drywall. I have been told that a contractor's license is not required, but then I've also been asked for our contractor's license number on some jobs. Please assist with your expert opinion.

A: If the project is over \$500 in labor and materials, then yes, a contractor's license is required. The most appropriate license classification for the removal of damaged building materials and drying out the structure, but with no reconstruction, is the "C-61"/"D-64" Non-Specialized classification. The CSLB will likely give the classification a title of "water remediation", or something similar.



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#### INTRODUCTION

Concrete and cement are commonly used by many different companies both inside and outside of the construction industry. Additionally, depending on your industry or company, these two terms may be used interchangeably; however, these are two different products, and working with these products can expose you to harm if certain precautions are not practiced. In this lesson, we will cover the differences between concrete and cement, the hazards associated with these products, the personal protective equipment that may need to be worn when working with one or




both of these products, and the safe work practices associated with concrete and cement work.

#### THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN CONCRETE AND CEMENT

While many people use the terms "concrete" and "cement" interchangeably, these are two different products, so you may be asking what the differences between the two are.

Cement is a fine, powdery material that is commonly made by using a combination of calcium, silica, alumina, and iron. These components are then heated up in a kiln to form a nodular (i.e., lump) material known as "clinker." The clinker is then ground down into a fine powder. The powdered material is then used as an ingredient in other mixtures to create other products. These other products include things such as:

- Concrete
  - When used for concrete, cement is commonly sold in ready to make mixes.
- Mortar
- Bricks
- Grout
- Stucco
- As an art medium to create sculptures



Concrete, on the other hand, is made up of three primary ingredients, which include cement, water, and aggregate (rock, sand, and/or gravel). Additionally, other additives and/or admixtures will sometimes be added to concrete mixtures to help modify certain properties of the concrete, such as to make it more fluid, speed up the setting time, resist freezing, etc.









#### **HAZARDS**

When you are working with cement mixtures or concrete mixtures, you could be exposed to one or more of the following hazards:

- Exposure to respirable crystalline dust, which prolonged exposure can lead to the development of a lung disease known as silicosis.
  - o For more information on this lung disease, please refer to our "Silicosis" lesson.
- · Respiratory irritation when you breathe in cement or concrete dust.
- Skin irritation or dermatitis from either an allergic reaction to one or more ingredients that are found in cement/concrete, the aggregates that have been mixed into concrete mixtures, or the alkaline compounds that are formed during a chemical reaction of the dry mixture with water.
  - Please note that allergies to cement/concrete mixtures can develop over time and may not be immediately apparent. If you are concerned about a potential allergy, please speak with your medical provider.
- Caustic burns to your skin if wet cement/concrete remains on your skin.
  - Caustic burns occur due to alkaline compounds that can have an acid effect that penetrates the different layers of skin. Depending on the person and the amount of time that wet cement/concrete was allowed to stay on the skin, burns can range from first to third degree burns.
- Eye irritation or damage if dry dust or wet mixtures get into your eyes
- Strain injuries from lifting bags of cement into mixers or from the spreading of wet concrete.





#### PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

To help minimize your exposure to dust and wet mixtures, you should wear the appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) when working with cement or concrete mixtures. PPE may include:

- Hard hat
- · Safety Glasses or Goggles
- Face Shield
- Long-Sleeved Shirts and Pants
- Water-Proof Gloves
- Water-Proof Boots
- Respirator

You should inspect all provided PPE for wear or damage before you put it on. Report worn or damaged items to your supervisor. Do NOT wear damaged PPE.

#### SAFE WORK PRACTICES

#### When Mixing Concrete/Cement Mixtures

When you are mixing concrete or cement mixtures, you should do the following:

Only allow trained and authorized personnel to mix cement or concrete mixtures.





- Read the manufacturer-provided safety data sheet for information about the ingredients contained in the dry mix, along with other safety information related to the product.
  - If you have questions regarding any of the information on the safety data sheet, please speak with your supervisor.
- Make sure that you will be mixing in a well-ventilated area.
  - Depending on the amount of dust that is anticipated to be produced from opening bags of cement/dry concrete mixtures or if you will be cutting into dry concrete, you may be required to wear a respirator.
  - Respirators should be worn in accordance with your company's policies and procedures. If you have questions regarding the use of respirators when working with cement or concrete, please speak with your supervisor.
- Inspect all tools and/or equipment that will be used for the mixing of cement or concrete for worn, missing, modified, or damaged parts or components.
  - Report all tools and/or equipment that does not pass inspection to your supervisor.
  - Do NOT use any damaged tools and/or equipment when mixing cement or concrete mixtures.
- Use all tools and/or equipment in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions and your company's policies and procedures.
  - O Do NOT operate tools and/or equipment if you are under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
    - If you are on prescription medication that could affect your ability to safely use or operate tools and/or equipment, please speak with your supervisor.
- Mix mixtures in accordance with your company's policies and procedures.
  - If you are using ready to use bag mixtures, these mixtures should be mixed in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
  - If you have questions about how to mix a mixture, please speak with your supervisor.
- Where provided and/or feasible, use a splash guard when mixing.

#### When Working with Wet Cement or Concrete Mixtures

When working with wet cement or concrete mixtures, you should do the following:

- Only allow trained and authorized personnel to work with wet cement or concrete.
- Where applicable, tape or otherwise secure cuffs and/or the tops of boots in accordance with your company's policies and procedures.
  - To help minimize the chances of wet cement or concrete making contact with bare skin, some companies will sometimes have employees close open areas of clothing and footwear.
  - If wet cement or concrete gets into clothing or footwear. it can hold the mixture close to the skin, which can lead to caustic burns.
  - If you have questions about the taping or otherwise securing of open areas of clothing or footwear, please speak with your supervisor.
- Where it is feasible, avoid making direct contact with wet cement or concrete as much as possible.
  - o This can be done in a number of ways, including the use of the following:
    - Trowels and Floats
    - Concrete Screeds
    - Concrete Buggies
    - Concrete Pumps (For more information on concrete pumps, please refer to our "Concrete Boom Pumps" lesson.)
    - Concrete Vibrators
    - Knee Pads
    - A Dry Board
- If wet cement or concrete soaks into your clothing, you should immediately remove the clothing and wash the area with clean water.





- Do NOT use water from buckets that have been used to clean cement or concrete from tools
  or other items, as this water is not considered clean and can have the same effects as wet
  cement or concrete on your skin.
- If you notice irritation or burns on your skin after wet cement or concrete has made contact, notify your supervisor.
  - Seek immediate medical attention if skin irritation persists or if burns appear, as burns can worsen without proper treatment.
- Wash your hands before eating, drinking, smoking, or applying cosmetics (including lip balm).
- Apply and work with wet cement and concrete mixtures in accordance with your company's policies and procedures.

#### CONCLUSION

To conclude, cement and concrete are used by a variety of companies for many purposes. Some companies may use these words interchangeably, but they are two different products. However, whether you are working with cement or concrete, they can expose you and others to harm if certain precautions are not followed, such as exposure to respirable crystalline silica or caustic burns. To help minimize the chances of someone getting sick or hurt, you should work with these products in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions and your company's policies and procedures.
